GOD'S PEOPLE GATHER TO WORSHIP

AS YOU PREPARE FOR WORSHIP

From the Diary of the Rev. Joseph Badger: Warren-Nov. 18, 1803: Six persons met together for the purpose of conferring together on the subject of uniting together in the covenant of relations of a Church of Christ. After prayer to Almighty God for direction, an examination was had of all Gospels and the evidences of their Christian hope. Having obtained satisfaction of each other as to their agreement in doctrine and the evidences of their Christian hope, it was agreed to adjourn till tomorrow and after sermon to adopt a Confession of Faith to which they had attended and to unite in church covenant.

Saturday, Nov. 19, 1803: Constituted a small church in Warren with the following persons by name: Elder William Prior and Betsey his wife, Thomas Ross and Rosalinda his wife, Sarah Davis, and Sarah Lane: after which Rev. Tait preached.

ALTERNATIVE GIFT-GIVING: Today's AGG Spotlight is on **Second Harvest Food Bank.** In spite of mounting challenges, the Second Harvest Food Bank continues to distribute food to the needy in the tri-county area. Recent years have been particularly difficult. The number of residents needing assistance is always increasing; food deserts are multiplying; donations to school pantries have skyrocketed. Due to this, Second Harvest has had to spend 200% more on food to fill its shelves. As you are enjoying your Thanksgiving feast, think of these numbers from 2024: Second Harvest distributed 10.6 million pounds of food, filled over 960,000 requests for food assistance, and provided over eight million total meals; and still the need increases. Of those served, 28% were children and 26% were senior citizens. Because of inflation, they can now only distribute up to five meals for every \$1 donated. FPC is a beneficiary of this mission for our monthly community lunch program. The need is real! For I was hungry, and You gave me food..." (Matthew 25:35)

Other participating organizations include Animal Welfare League, FPC Wish List – ACTS Fund, Free Indeed Ministry, Pink Lights the Way, and Water for the People. Remember to make out your check to First Presbyterian Church (put AGG on the memo line) and to include your order blank with the name(s) of your designated charity(ies). You can drop your donation into the offering plate or mail it to the FPC office. Alternative Gift-Giving will continue through Dec. 15.
