Walter and Martha Conyer-Allen, the Free Indeed Ministry Program aids men and women recently released from prison by providing them with household and personal items and by helping them find employment. The Allens also lead church services at the Women's Reintegration Center in Cleveland. A recent endeavor has been the creation of a successful community garden and greenhouse on Fifth Street. Certified by the U.S. Department of Agriculture as an urban farm, this garden/greenhouse provides fresh fruit and vegetables to the food desert in Warren's 6th Ward. Rev. Allen also presents seminars on violence prevention at area prisons. "I was in prison and you came to visit me." (Matthew 25:36,40)
