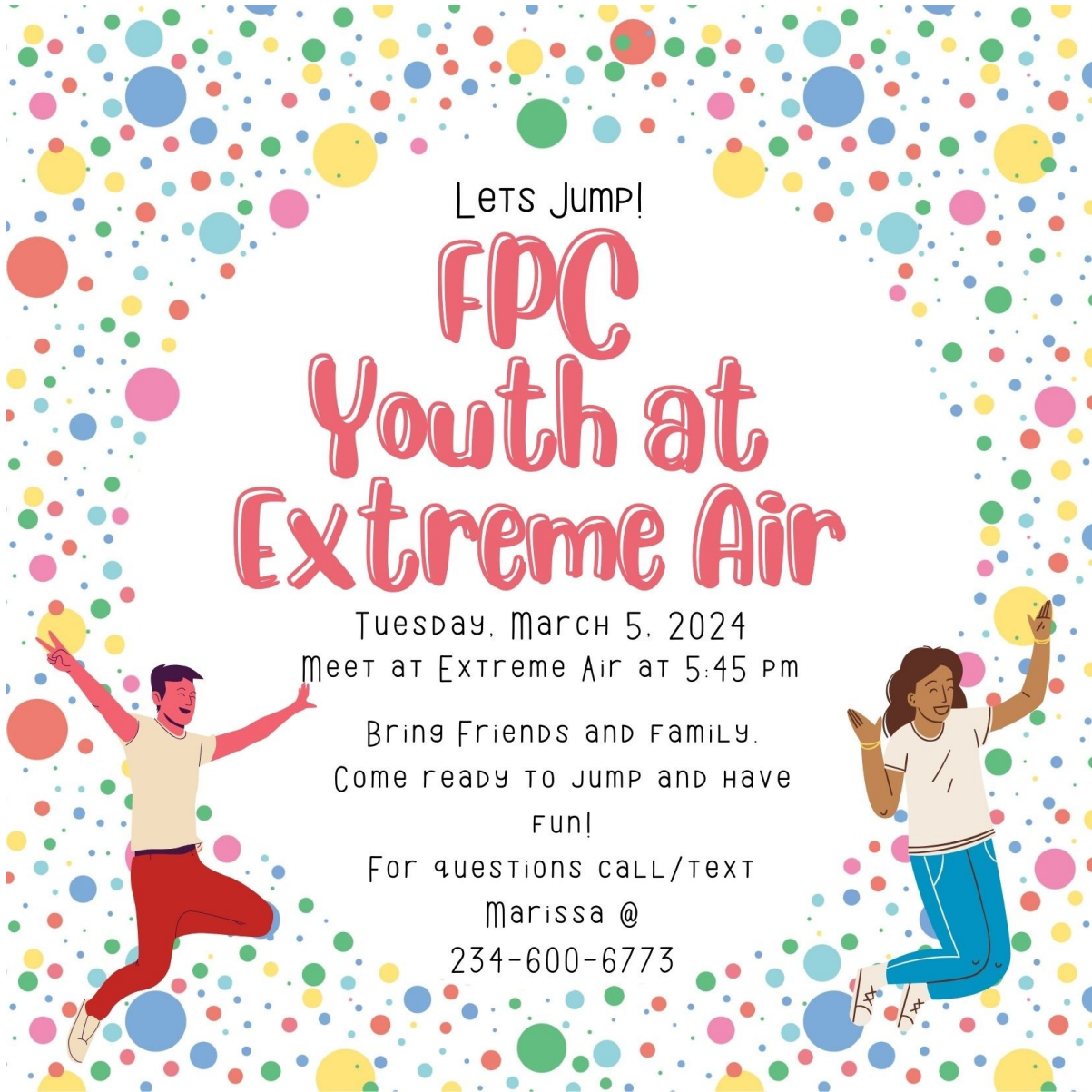

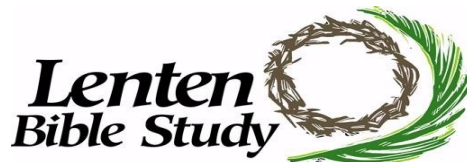
1. Beer Battered Haddock dinner with fries and coleslaw
